

Tangihanga Process

- Alert Level 4

No-one, except the whānau pani who has been living with the loved one who has passed, may be physically present during any tangi, cremation, or burial arrangements or processes.

Unwell or vulnerable people within the whānau pani must remain in the whare and not attend any tangi, cremation or burial arrangements or processes. This is to protect everyone from further community transmission of COVID-19 and will save lives.

Email, text, and phone contact can still go ahead as normal. Consider using technology options so the wider whānau can participate remotely in cremation or burial processes.
